WALKABOUT, STREET ACTS & SPECTACLE PHOTOGRAPHER BRIEF

As you may know, Brisfest offers more than just music. In honor of its return to Ashton Court for the 2nd year the festival will play host to a huge variety of non-musical entertainment.

Please see the bullet-points for some ideas about the types of shots we would you to take:

- Walkabouts, street acts and spectacles entertaining and interacting with either large or small groups of festival-goers
- Performers interacting with people of all ages.
- Close-up shots of individual performers in full swing
- Group shots of performers
- Performers backstage preparing for shows. Before and after shots, ie. 'Hair' and 'Make-up'
- Performers in full swing at different times during the day
- Shots that include festival-goers reactions to Walkabouts, Street acts and spectacles
- The nightly fancy dress parade. The theme this year is Night Lights, so expecting lots of glow sticks, bright neon colors – lots of pictures of all the different outfits would be great
- All across site there will be sculptures and artwork from renowned local artists throughout the festival, pictures capturing these, and people interacting, appreciating these items.

We need you to explore this kind entertainment, the walkabouts, street acts and spectacles that make a festival unique and exciting. Below is an example of non-musical entertainment Brisfest has this year, there will be many more for you to discover.

POLICE RAVE UNIT

'The Police Rave Unit is a specially adapted riot van, equipped with a full sound and light show. Overseen by 2CI Wogan and Inspector Smerin, the Unit provides impromptu performances across the festival site, and complies fully with the 2013 Police Rave Act. It includes classic cuts across a spectrum of dance music, whilst keeping it 'legal on the mic'.
